Friday, July 3rd and Saturday, July 4th - All branches of EMPL will be CLOSED.

Free Weekday Matinee Classic Film: M*A*S*H (1970) – Tuesday, July 7th, 2pm–4pm – Community Room – Set during the Korean War, the film follows the staff of an Army field hospital as they cope with the chaos of war through outrageous pranks, sharp humor, and nonstop hijinks. Rated R for sexual content. Shown with closed captions/English subtitles. Doors open 1:30pm.

Free Evening Classic Film: Raiders of the Lost Ark (1981) – Thursday, July 9th, 5:30pm–7:30pm – Community Room – A special evening classic movie showing! Set in the 1930s, the film follows archaeologist and adventurer Indiana Jones as he races to find the legendary Ark of the Covenant. Rated PG for action violence/ frightening images. Shown with closed captions/English subtitles. Doors open 5pm.
